GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1. The applicant understands that under the provision of subsection 110(5) of the Highway Traffic Act the owner, operator or mover of a heavy vehicle, load, object or structure in respect of which a permit is granted under this section who has obtained a permit is nevertheless responsible for all damages that may be caused to the highway, by reason of the driving, operating or moving of any such heavy vehicle load, object or structure.
- 2. The applicant certifies that the Information contained in this application is true and acknowledges and accepts the responsibilities imposed by law on the applicant in relation to the operation of a commercial motor vehicle under the authority of the permit(s) issued pursuant to this application.
- 3. The applicant agrees for himself/herself, his/her heirs, executors, and administrators to indemnify and save have the City of St. Catharines from any action, claim, damage, or loss whatsoever, arising from operation carried out under this permit. Prior to undertaking any move in this regard, the applicant shall deposit with the City a form of insurance naming <u>The Corporation of the City of St. Catharines</u> as an additional insured on the policy. A minimum of \$5 Million General Liability per occurrence is required.
- 4. The permit is only valid for the listed road sections that are under the jurisdiction of the City of St. Catharines. Separate permits must be obtained from other jurisdictions where there roads are impacted by the travel route (e.g. Region of Niagara, Ministry of Transportation)
- 5. The use of any road or structure may be restricted at any time.
- 6. This permit may be withdrawn upon written notice at any time by the City.
- 7. Notwithstanding the issuance of this permit, the operator/carrier is subject to all applicable laws and regulations within the Province of Ontario.
- 8. This permit must be carried in the vehicle at all times.
