## ANNUAL APPLICATION FOR VETERAN PARKING PERMIT

**Instructions**: Mail or deliver completed form along with photocopies of **proof of service and proof of residence** to: City of St. Catharines, Parking Services (address below) free of charge. Application is required annually.

**Please note**: The Veteran Permit allows a Veteran (3) free hours of parking at any City meter or ticket dispenser lot. The permit is non-transferable. The Veteran must be travelling in the vehicle and the permit must be displayed. All other provisions of the City of St. Catharines parking by-laws, including but not limited to, the time limit of the meter or lot, must be obeyed, otherwise a parking fine may be issued. All required information must be submitted to consider the application complete.

Eligibility Criteria For Veteran Parking Permit
The Veteran permit is only available to a <b>St. Catharines resident</b> who is or has honourably:
A) Served in the Canadian Forces including the Reserve Forces, the forces of the Commonwealth or its wartime allies and has retired
B) Served in the Merchant Navy or Ferry Command during wartime
C) Served in NATO operations or as a member of a United Nations peacekeeping force as a member of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police or another Canadian police service
D) Served in the Vietnam War in the forces of the United States or its allies during this war and who was a Canadian citizen at the time of service

A photocopy of the following documentation must be attached:
Retired Personnel - Copy of Canadian Forces discharge certificate, certificate of service (or equivalent for Merchant Navy, Allied Forces, etc.) or ND175 CF Identification card
Police Personnel – Letter from the applicant's police service confirming his/her involvement in a NATO operation or a United Nations mission
Vietnam Service – Statement of service or discharge certificate showing service in Vietnam during the Vietnam War in the United States forces or the forces of its allies during this war and proof of Canadian citizenship at the time of service (Canadian birth certificate or citizenship document, which shows date of becoming a Canadian citizen.
