


# Social Well-Being

- Facilitate greater certainty on underground infrastructure capacity
- Increase City capacity for volunteerism and community engagement through best practices

- Strive for a corporate reduction in emissions of 40 to 45 per cent by 2023 and net zero by 2050
- Work toward an integrated multi-modal transportation network that facilitates the movement of people and goods
- Ensure community planning is consistent with environmental sustainability through compliance with Garden City Plan, Regional Official Plan Amendments and Provincial Policy Statement
- Pursue opportunities aligned with the Ontario Climate Change Action Plan
- Comply with new Consolidated Linear Infrastructure Requirement
- Increase use of permeable materials
- Communicate successes to the community and advocate for support from other levels of government
