



Vote Tabulator Operator

SUMMARY OF DUTIES: The Vote Tabulator Operator feeds ballots into the vote tabulator and prints the candidate results tape using preprogrammed vendor software.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Report to the Poll Supervisor and notify any incidents that occur or complaints that are made at a voting location in a timely manner.
- 2. Ensure the voting location is free of any campaign materials.
- 3. Verify that the tabulator case and ballot box have been delivered to the voting location.
- 4. Turn on the tabulator and print tapes that indicate a zero balance prior to the poll opening.
- 5. Insert the ballots into the vote tabulator.
- 6. Assist the voter in the automated voting process.
- 7. Educate voters on the status of their ballot if the vote tabulator rejects a ballot.
- 8. Close the poll and generate the tabulated results on election night and power down the vote tabulator.
- 9. Pack-up the equipment to be delivered back to City Hall.
- 10. Manage a large flow of electors within a voting location.
- 11. Assist with cleaning up the voting location.

POSITION REQUIREMENTS:

- Available to work up to 12 hours on election day
- Available to attend a training session
- Ability to read and observe voting procedures at the voting location
- Strong interpersonal communication and customer service skills
- Ability to stand for long periods of time
- Ability to learn and adapt quickly and complete repetitive duties
- Ability to multi-task
