

Victoria Lawn Cemetery Rules and Regulations

1. Funerals shall enter the Cemetery only at the main gateways near the office. Cullinan mausoleum interments and Queenston Courtyard Columbarium excepted.
2. Children under the age of twelve years when in the Cemetery shall be in the charge of an adult except with the permission of the Manager.
3. The riding of bicycles is prohibited except in driveways and a bicycle shall not be left on any lot.
4. No person shall deposit rubbish or debris on the Cemetery grounds except in receptacles provided.
5. No person shall install, alter, repair, maintain, relocate or remove any marker or supplies, or any decoration or other thing on a lot except in accordance with the By-Law.
6. No person shall write upon, deface or injure any marker, fence or other structure, or any tree in the Cemetery.
7. No person shall break any tree or shrub or pick any flowers, wild or cultivated, in the Cemetery.
8. Plants, flowers, holders or other articles shall not be removed without permission from the Manager.
9. No person shall decorate a lot except in accordance with the provisions of this By-Law and the following:
 - a) Ornamental shrubs may be placed by an interment rights holder on either side of an upright marker on a lot which is not a single grave;
 - b) A flower bed may be planted on a lot by an interment rights holder and maintained immediately in front of an upright marker of a length not greater than the length of such marker and in any event of width not greater than eighteen inches;
 - c) Arose bush shall not be planted or maintained on a lot;
 - d) No object, including any statue or tripod, maybe placed on a lot except markers which are in accordance with this By-Law, and disposable containers for plants and flowers;
 - e) The earth of a flower bed shall not be covered with stone, mulch or other material;
 - f) The grade of a lot shall not be changed and no mound of earth may be made or maintained on a lot except with the permission of the Manager;
 - g) Except in the mausoleum, artificial wreaths and flowers shall be permitted from the first day of November in each year to the first day of April in the following year.
10. Nothing shall be placed upon or added to a lot which shall interfere with the maintenance of the Cemetery by the Corporation.
11. Any structures, enclosures or additions to a lot which are not in good condition are

subject to removal by the Cemetery.

12. Floral tributes and potted plants, plantings, artificial flowers, and wreaths are subject to removal by the Manager at any time.

13. Permanent receptacles for cut flowers are permitted only if installed with the approval of the Manager either flush with the ground or as part of a marker.

14. The Manager may remove, prune or alter any tree or shrub in a lot.

15. Any grading, sodding, seeding, top dressing, fertilizing and watering of lots, sodding and covering of graves and planting of trees and shrubs shall be done under the supervision of the Manager.

16. The Corporation shall not be responsible for any damage to lots and structures, objects, flowers or articles removed from any lot.

17. No person shall bring or permit any animal to enter upon or remain in the Cemetery.

18. Any person disturbing the quiet or good order of the Cemetery by noise or other improper conduct, or who shall violate any of the provisions of this By-Law or any other By-Law of the Corporation, may be required to leave the grounds forthwith.

19. The Cemetery will be open to visitors from sunrise to sunset.

20. No person shall enter the Cemetery when the Cemetery is not open to visitors except only police officers, authorized employees of the Corporation, or persons permitted by the Manager.

Monument regulations

No monument may be erected which is composed in whole or part of (a) wood, (b) metal, (c) marble veneer or other veneer, (d) block or cement facing of exterior, or (e) of any material not of a permanent nature and durable quality. Before placing an order to purchase a headstone, please obtain confirmation from the Manager that the marker complies with cemetery regulations.

- Cremation and Infant's Graves: Flat Marker Only. Solid granite marker with no base or foundation not exceeding 18" x 12" minimum thickness 4"
- Section S Cremation: Flat Marker Only: Solid granite marker with no base or foundation not exceeding 24" x 14" minimum thickness 4"
- Cremation and Infant's Graves: Upright with Base in Designated Areas only Solid granite, minimum 8" die and no larger than 20" x 28". Base, no larger than 26"x14"x8"
- Single Graves: Flat Marker Designation. Solid granite marker with no base or foundation not exceeding 24"x18", minimum thickness of 4".
- Single Graves: Upright with Base in Designated Areas. Solid granite, minimum 8" die and no larger than 20" x 20". Base no larger than 26"x14"x8".
- Two-Grave-Lot: Upright with Base. Solid granite with an 8" die having a base not exceeding 3'6" in length, 18" in width and the monument being no higher than 5 feet.
- Foot Marker: Flat Marker Only

- Solid granite marker with no base or foundation not exceeding 18" x 12" minimum thickness 4". To be placed on at the foot of grave and centered.
