Parks Renewal Plan – Burgoyne Woods Playground / Pickleball Courts

Burgoyne Woods Park

Please be advised that the contract for the construction of the park upgrades at Burgoyne Woods Park has been awarded. The successful Contractor, **Niagara Concrete Forming and Finishing Limited**, is tentatively scheduled to start work in **February 2026** with completion by **June 2026**. The work includes excavation, asphalt paving, concrete works, installation of playground, pickle ball courts, fencing and shelter structures, rubberized playground surface and sports surface paint. Final restoration being completed within the noted timeline, weather permitting.

Approximate Location of Construction Limits



The proposed project includes:



- Removal of existing playground and installation of a new playground, complete with rubberized surface, concrete pad, furniture and shade structure.
- Installation of eight new asphalt pickleball courts with fencing, furniture, specialized sports surface, and shade structure.
- One lane extension of existing parking lot.
- Associated grading, surface swales and subdrains related to the new works.

This work is tentatively scheduled to start Mid-February 2026, and in order to complete the construction in a timely manner please note the following:

- The tennis court will be restricted starting May 10th, 2024. A portion of the parking lot will be sectioned off for the contractor's use and access to the site.
- The access to the playground, pool, and trail will remain open throughout construction. Some intermittent traffic management or detours can be expected for cars and pedestrians. At some point the parking lot will be closed for regrading.
- Subsequent notices will be issued for any additional park closures during construction.
- The work will involve heavy and light construction equipment and will access the park from Sculler's Way. The contractor will adhere to traffic management plans and allow for pedestrian and vehicular traffic. No road closures are anticipated.
