Garden City Golf Course

Garden City Golf Course will be open this Thanksgiving for bookings only. The City-run golf course will be open from 7 a.m. to dusk all weekend, including Monday. Community Centres

Russell Avenue Community Centre will be open for registered programs on Saturday only. Port Weller will be open on Saturday for drop-in Pickleball 12:30 p.m. to 4 p.m. on and registered programs.
